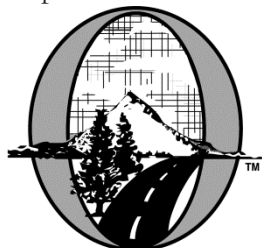

We'll **tour this charming European-style Estate and winery** before our **tasting and scrumptious lunch....** We continue south through the beautiful Umpqua Valley to our home for the next two nights **the Historic Ashland Springs Hotel**... (formerly the Mark Antony)... It has been transformed into a haven of taste and elegance reminiscent of Small European hotels. You'll have plenty of time to get cozy in your room before we head next door to **the Oregon Cabaret Theatre for a wonderful Dinner Show... “Let’s Misbehave”**... It's 1935 in the wee hours of the morning in Dorothy's stylish New York apartment where **a swell party** has just ended. Dorothy, Walter and Alice linger over a nightcap and some delicious gossip. The three friends delight in each other's company... until the witty banter and fun reveal a complicated triangle of affections.... Written by **Cole Porter** this hilarious romp will delight everyone.... The next morning we'll **“Meet and Greet” an OSF Actor**.
