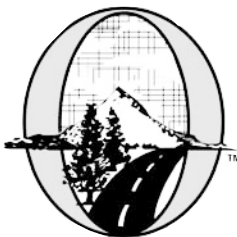


We'll fly non-stop to "Gold Country", Sacramento. When James Marshall discovered gold near Sacramento in 1848, it set off the famous California Gold Rush. Many of those seeking their own gold arrived here by boat on the Sacramento River, entering the city in what is now called "Old Sacramento". Today, this 28-acre historic park is a must-see destination! Strolling on wood sidewalks past the historic buildings you'll feel like you have stepped back in time about 100 years. "Old Town" features some of the region's best restaurants, quirky shops and museums..... Put your dancing shoes on.... it's time to board the Famous Fun Train..... it features: First class reclining seats with picture windows, historical narration, strolling minstrels, a 1940s-era piano lounge car... where the furniture is comfy and the pianist knows a dizzying array of tunes, a dance car... featuring the FunAtics, a four-piece dance band that converts to a strolling Dixieland combo during depot stops, a dome car... to view tremendous mountain vistas and the snow-capped peaks above!

Welcome to the Biggest Little City in the World - Reno.... Your evening and next day is free to do as you wish.... Included in our "Fun Train Package" is a "Winner's Coupon Book"..... it has coupons for Shows, Restaurants, Museums etc..... Our home for the next 2 nights is Harrah's East Tower.... If you're looking for entertainment Harrah's is the place. Enjoy everything from live music to comedy in the showrooms. It also has more than a dozen shops, spa, pool, a salon and is located in the heart of downtown Reno.... Our train ride back to Sacramento is filled with the same beauty, albeit with daylight views of the Sierras eastern slopes. Back in Sacramento we'll visit the California State Railroad Museum. It is a complex of historic facilities and unique attractions and is widely regarded as one of North America's finest railroad museums.

Our next day is exciting! We're headed out to Sutter Gold Mine for a tour that takes us deep into the heart of the Motherlode! Learn the history of mining, mining safety and the geology of the area. Next travel the Shenandoah Valley wine region in the Sierra Foothills. Rising out of the Foothills is Bella Piazza, a magnificent winery. Enjoy the splendid surroundings while we have a catered lunch and wine tasting. Tonight we'll be dining aboard an authentic 285 foot riverboat, the Delta King. She was christened in May 1927 and began her daily river voyages between San Francisco and Sacramento. Although she doesn't cruise any longer, she remains a permanent landmark on the river. Your plans for a quiet dinner aboard the magnificently restored riverboat have suddenly turned into a "Who-Done-It" thriller. Welcome to Suspects Murder Mystery Dinner Theatre.

It's time to head home but the fun isn't over yet.... we're off to tour the State Capitol building in Sacramento. It is a wonderful "Mini White House" and a must see. Maybe Arnold will be our tour guide? Don't miss out on this one!!!
