Its picturesque Old Town is a UNESCO World Heritage site, a living museum of narrow cobblestone streets, 17th- and 18th-century houses, and soaring church spires with the splendid Château Frontenac towering above it all. There's more than a glimmer of Old Europe in its classic bistros, sidewalk cafes, and manicured squares.

Welcome to **Montreal** the largest city in Canada's Québec province. It's set on an island in the Saint Lawrence River and named after Mt. Royal, the triple-peaked hill at its heart.

We'll kick this one off with a **sightseeing cruise on St. Lawrence River...** weigh anchor and discover Montréal from the river. Enjoy breathtaking views of the downtown. Learn more about the metropolis with your guide or relax on outdoor terraces. **Next... the world-famous Montreal Tower**, at 541 feet high with a 45-degree angle, the Montreal Tower is the tallest inclined tower in the world. It is an architectural masterpiece! The funicular will take you on a breathtaking ride to the top. The view from the tower's observatory is stunning!


We'll start today with a **walking tour of Montreal's Underground City...** the name applied to a series of interconnected office towers, hotels, shopping centers, residential and commercial complexes, universities and performing arts venues that form the heart of Montreal's central business district. See how the buildings of the city and their different underground passageways make Montreal so unique. After a little free time, we'll head to **Quebec City our home for the next 3 nights!**

After breakfast we'll have a **guided city tour of Quebec City...** Experience the European charm of the first French settlement in North America. This is your chance to visit history first hand. This will be the perfect introduction to the city. **Your afternoon is free to explore "Old Town"** an area with a rich history and vibrant streets. It's home to some of Canada's best restaurants, most interesting historical buildings, and, overall, is a veritable post-card!

Today we'll head to **Montmorency Falls...** Higher than Niagara Falls, the impressive Falls stand 272 feet tall. We'll take the gondola up the side of the 270 ft falls. There are multiple vantage points that will give you tons of picture taking opportunities. **Next, it's Sainte Anne de Beaupre...** Welcome to the oldest pilgrimage site in North America! The Shrine has been welcoming people from all walks of life for over 350 years. It is dedicated to Saint Anne, the grandmother of Jesus. You're in for a real treat tonight... We'll delight in a **Traditional Sugar Shack Dinner...** Tables are set with all kinds of sausage, bacon, meatballs etc. and jugs of maple syrup, visitors are told the syrup can be poured on practically anything. Dessert is usually pancakes and crepes, where, of course, more syrup is a welcome addition.

Today we're off for **Montreal and Notre Dame Basilica of Montreal...** it is the first church of the Gothic Revival style in Canada. It bears witness to its Catholic foundations and the ever-present connections between the arts and religion. Its architectural style marked a turning point in the religious tradition and was imitated by several parishes.

We'll head home today thinking we may have been on a European Vacation... without the jet-lag!
