South we go... first stop is a **tasty lunch at Tolly's in Oakland**. Nestled among other historic brick buildings, is this fine dining restaurant, features an old time soda fountain, a charming courtyard, and the warm ambiance of the past. We'll continue south to our home for the night... the **Riverside Inn with large balconies overlooking the beautiful Rogue River**. You'll have some time to rest up before we walk next door for our **Hellgate Jetboat Excursions...** Get ready for the fun as we're whisked down the Rogue River into the legendary Hellgate Canyon. You'll view old floodwater marks on the narrow heights above and close-ups of remarkable rock shapes carved by the river's hydraulics. See the canyon where John Wayne and Katherine Hepburn filmed "Rooster Cogburn", and Matt Dillon plunged into the depths to escape a gang in hot pursuit in "Gunsmoke". On the return trip we'll stop at the **OK Corral for a dinner you'll not soon forget**.




Today, we'll travel through **Six Rivers National Forest on gorgeous Highway 199**, into California. We'll hug the Redwood Coast Highway alongside the spectacular **Smith River**. You'll want to keep your camera handy, as we're **in Redwood country!** First stop; **The Trees of Mystery**, where we'll be greeted by Paul Bunyan - America's larger than life logger, and Babe the Blue Ox! **Enjoy lunch at The Forest Cafe** before we venture into the awe-inspiring **Redwoods aboard the Sky Trail Gondola**. You'll hear all about **The Trail of Tall Tales** devoted to the myth and mythology of Paul Bunyan. Our final destination today is the **Victorian Seaport of Eureka**. The town was born and raised in the timber industry, with some fishing on the side, and earned a well-deserved reputation for being a bit wild. Eureka's waterfront could give the Barbary Coast a run for its money, so much so that writer Jack London came here in search of authentic tough guys to base his characters on. Relax before a great dinner tonight!

Today, we'll be joined by a **wonderful guide, Ray Hillman**. He'll take us on a journey into the pure majestic beauty of the Redwoods Forest. A stroll in this forest is a quick "ego correction". You'll know your place in the universe after a **walk amongst Giant Redwoods**. **Afterwards, enjoy a picnic lunch**. We'll head back to Eureka where we'll learn the history of Humboldt Bay and Eureka's waterfront during a **75-minute narrated cruise on the Madaket...** traveling along the shores of the bay. During your cruise, the Captain explains local history, industries, activities, points of interests and wildlife. Tonight we'll sample some of Eureka's best food.

Breakfast this morning is lumber camp style, at the **last surviving cookhouse in the West; The Samoa Cook-house**. Next, we'll head **north to the Spectacular Oregon Coast**. Stroll Brookings' harbor-shops and grab a bite! Soon we arrive at **our Oceanfront Hotel**. After a rest, or stroll on the beach, join us next door for a **fabulous dinner at Lord Bennett's**.

The next morning we're off for the **West Coast Game Park**. This is the original walk through Safari, where we can meet, pet, film, or walk among hundreds of free roaming wildlife. The animals have been specially raised for 28 years by the park owners. Imagine majestic adult lions, tigers, snow leopards, bears and more!
